NOTICE OF RACE

Overview:

Notification until	Thursday, Mai 16, 2019, late notification until registration with late entry fee 10, - / sailor.
Registration	Thursday, May 30, 2019, from 18:00 to 20:00 and Friday, Mai 31, 2019, from 9:00 to 11:45
First Warning signal	Friday, May 31, 2019 from 13:30
Last Warning signal	There will be no Warning signal after 14:00 on Sunday, June 02, 2019.
Race courses	Standard courses with a target time of 40 minutes.
Scoring	8 races, one score will be excluded. If less than 4 races are sailed, no score will be excluded.
Entry fee	60, - per crew member. Children up to the age of 17 are free of entry.
Expected framework program	Friday, May 31, 2019, about 20:00, evening event at the invitation of the Organizing Committee. Saturday, June 01, 2019, about 18:30, sailing dinner at the invitation of AGS. Sunday, June 02, 2019, award ceremony about 1.5 hours after the end of the last race.
Slipway	A slipway is provided next to the sailing club.
Other boat classes	At the Traunsee week more regattas take place at the same time in the 5 clubs on Lake Traunsee. The AGS hosts regattas of the classes on the same regatta course: Seascope 18, Seascope 24, Lago 26, Splash / Flash and Yardstick (separate Starts). In addition, the AGS organizes a Surprise ÖSTM (Austrian State Championship) on a separate regatta course.

1 Rules

- 1.1** The Seascope 18 Central European Cup 2019 is subject to the Racing Rules of Sailing published by World Sailing (WRS).

- 1.2 In addition, the Race Regulation of the Austrian Sailing Federation OeSV 2019 applies; further the standard Sailing Instructions of the OeSV 2019, the Sailing Instructions of the **AGS** and this Notice of Race.
- 1.3 The addition [DP] in a rule of the Notice of Race or in the Sailing Instructions means, that the penalty for a breach of rule is at the discretion of the protest committee and may be less than a disqualification.
- 1.4 If the Class Rules do not prescribe higher standards, ISO standard 12402-5 (or equivalent) is the minimum requirement for personal flotation devices.
- 1.5 The anti-doping rules of World Sailing and the anti-doping rules of the Austrian Bundessportorganisation shall apply. For doping suspended or blocked athletes and caregivers are not admitted to participate at the regatta.

2 Advertising

Organizing authorities may ask competitors to display advertising stickers of the event sponsor on the bow for the duration of the event. [DP]

3 Eligibility and notification

- 3.1 The Regatta is open to all boats of the Seascope 18 Class, registered in a club recognized to the ISAF and the **Seascope 18 / FIRST 18** Class. The Boats must be conformed the class rules and insured against liability damage (minimum cover EUR 1.500.000).
Contrary to class rules, an anchor is not required.
- 3.2 Helmsmen have to be members of a club recognized to their national authority or have to be individual members of their national authority.
- 3.3 Helmsmen are required to possess a sailing license from their national authority.
- 3.4 Participants who are entitled to participate will register online by **Thursday, May 16, 2019**, at www.ag-segeln.at, with simultaneous transfer of the entree fee to the **AGS**.
- 3.5 Late entries will be accepted at a Late Entry Fee of **€ 10,-**, so they arrive in time before the end of the registration.
- 3.6 There is a minimum of **8** entries at entry closing date **Thursday, May 16, 2019**.
If this minimum number is not reached, so the regatta can be cancelled.
- 3.7 A boat is only eligible when it has completed the registration and all crew members have signed the disclaimer (liability, pictures, data).

4 Entry Fee

The Entry Fee is **€ 60,-** per crew member for bank transfer until **Thursday, Mai 16, 2019**.
Children and adolescents up to the age of 17 are free.

The Entry Fee must be paid into the **AGS** account at VOLKSBANK Vöcklabruck-Gmunden with the reason for payment "**Seascope 18 / FIRST 18 + Sail Number**".

5 Registration

Control certification, liability insurance, membership card and sailing license and issuing of sailing instructions.

Thursday, May 30, 2019, from 18:00 to 20:00 and

Friday, May 31, 2019, from 9:00 to 11:45, at the **AGS** office.

6 First Warning signal

Friday, May 31, 2019 from 13:30

7 Last Warning signal

There will be no Warning signal after **14:00** on Sunday, June 02, 2019.

8 Sailing instruction

The sailing instructions are distributed during registration

9 Race Courses

There will be standard courses with a target time of **40** minutes.

10 Wertung

8 races, one score will be excluded.

If less than 4 races are sailed, no score will be excluded.

3 completed races are required to constitute the Central European Cup.

No more than 4 races will be sailed per day.

The Low Point Scoring System of RRS Appendix A will apply.

11 Caregivers boats

The use of private caregiver boats is not permitted. [DP]

12 Mooring area

All boats must be moored on the assigned moorings. [DP]

13 Radio communication

Excluded in an emergency a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receive radio communications not available to all boats. [DP]

14 Awards

14.1 Prizes will be awarded to the first **3** boats.

14.2 Give-away for all participants.

15 Disclaimer, Pictures, Data

Racing competitors agree to be bound by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing. Racing competitors agree to take any and all responsibility for the nautical qualities of their boat, the rigging, the crew's ability and the safety equipment. Competitors also agree to take any and all responsibility for damages caused to third persons or their belongings, to themselves or to their belongings, ashore and at sea as a consequence of their participation in the Seascope 18 Central European Cup, relieving of any responsibility the Organizing Authority, the Jury, the International Seascope 18 Association and all National Seascope 18 Associations and all persons involved in their organization under whatever qualification and to accept full responsibility for the behaviour and dress of the boat's crew, representatives and guests.

In any case, competitors agree that the Organizing Authority, AGS, the International Seascope 18 Association and all National Seascope 18 Associations, the sponsors of the Traunseewoche and their agents, have no responsibility for loss of life or injury to members, competitors or others, or for the loss or damage to any vessel or property sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the Seascope 18 Central European Cup.

The Organizing Authority reminds the participants that there is commercial shipping traffic in the vicinity of the race area and the participants are expected to observe the IRPCAS in relation to all such vessels.

15.1 Recording in picture and sound

All participating persons agree with the announcement or participation that they and their boats take records in picture and sound and that these will be published indefinitely for reporting on the event and for their application, as well as for promoting the purposes of the organizing clubs allowed.

15.2 Minor

In the case of minors, their declarations of intent are to be issued by their legal representative or by a person authorized by the legal representative in writing.

15.3 Others

The organization of the event starts well in advance. Reimbursement of the registration fee or travel expenses is not provided. In exceptional cases and only to the extent that the organizer has spared something, the registration fee will be replaced; But not in cases of force majeure.

Any changes to the Notice of Race and other rules (such as sailing instructions) are reserved, but they are announced in a timely manner.

All prizes, in particular material and reminder prizes will be forfeited if these are not collected personally at the prize giving.

The law of the Republic of Austria shall apply to questions which are not subject to the sports federation's autonomy. Court of Jurisdiction is the local and factually competent court for Gmunden.

16 Insurance

All participating boat must have a valid liability insurance with a minimum sum of € 1,500,000 per casualty or the equivalent case of damage.
